Ibizan hounds in their native lands of Spain and the Balearic Islands are used to hunt in packs, capture and retrieve to hand live rabbits. 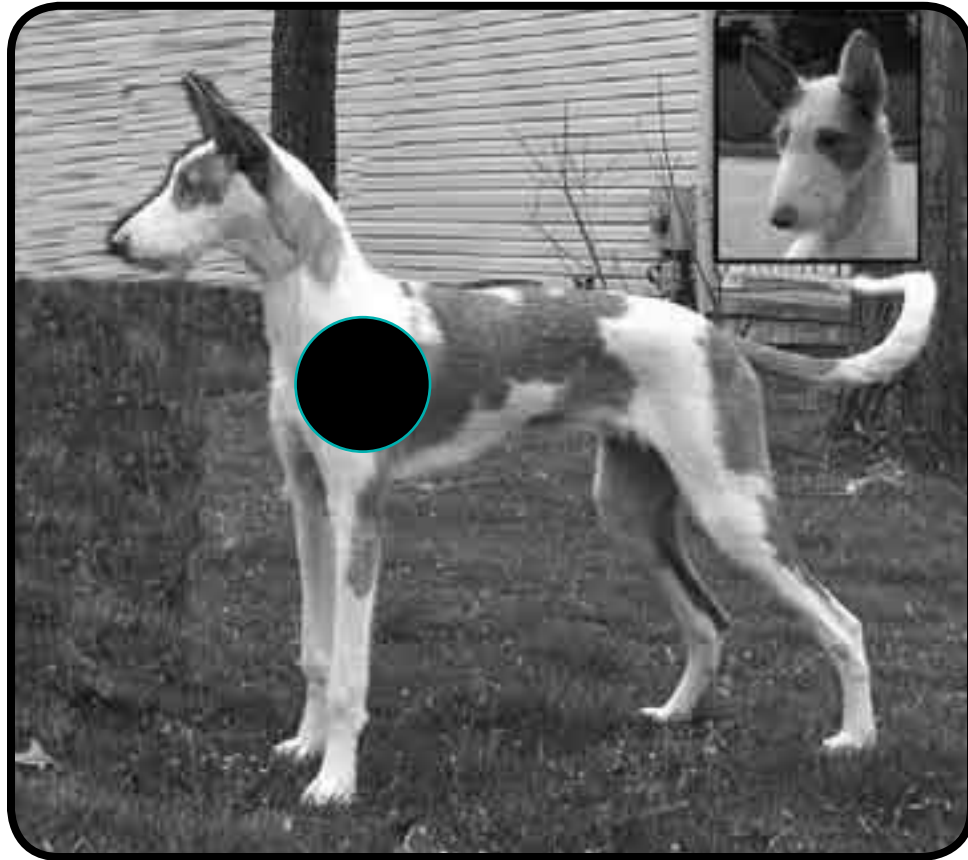

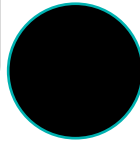
